Subject: Track Rentals, Unofficial Practice and Testing

This technical bulletin takes precedence over previously published rules, bulletins or approvals.

2.6 Track Rentals, Unofficial Practice and Testing

Starting January 1st of a given competition year, at facilities where American Flat Track events are to be held, exclusive track rentals or practice are not allowed by participants, including manufacturers, teams or individuals, unless approved by AMA Pro Racing. There are no restrictions on track rentals or practice in conjunction with regional race meets, promoter/racetrack organized open practice and open schools, except for the ten (10) days prior to the American Flat Track event.

Starting January 1st of a given competition year, at facilities where American Flat Track events are to be held, licensed riders, test riders, manufactures or teams are not allowed to participate in any exclusive or open track rentals, including promoter/racetrack organized open practice and open schools. AMA Pro Racing licensed riders, test riders, manufactures or teams may participate in regional race meets, except for the thirty (30) days prior to the American Flat Track event. AMA Pro Racing will make the final determination of what constitutes a test rider.

Tracks listed on the schedule for the current year may be rented <u>after</u> the last AFT event scheduled at the facility within the season.

Press days officially organized or recognized by AMA Pro Racing are exempt from this rule and invited riders will be allowed to ride at a racetrack within the 40 30-day limit. Riders participating in press days are limited to five (5) laps and are not allowed to utilize any data recording equipment or make any modifications or tuning changes to the motorcycle.
