3. Sturgis TT Event Information & Updates

- a. **Competition Format:** The Sturgis TT will be an AFT Championship round. Points and purse will be paid according to the standard AFT championship structure for the following classes:
 - i. Mission AFT SuperTwins
 - ii. Parts Unlimited AFT Singles presented by KICKER
 - iii. AFT AdventureTrackers

e. Track Details:

- i. **Length:** The total track length of the Sturgis TT track is 0.29 of a mile, which is the same length as the Castle Rock TT.
- ii. **Composition:** The track is approximately 25% dirt and 75% asphalt, which is the same ratio of dirt to asphalt as the 2020 DAYTONA TT track.
- iii. **Straights:** The longest straight is 365 feet, which is the same length as the straight at the DAYTONA Short Track.
- iv. Width: The majority of the track is 40' wide, the same width as the DAYTONA Short Track.
- v. **Corners:** The narrowest portion of Sturgis TT track is 28' wide in two locations (Turn 1 and Turn 4). Peoria's right hander is 18' to 20' wide. Buffalo Chip TT was 25' wide in Turn 1 and 28' wide through the right-hand turn complex surrounding the bar.
- vi. **Barriers:** The course will be defined with interconnected sections of longitudinal barriers (Yodock 2001 and Yodock 2001 MB) which have fencing attachments rising above to a height of over 9' tall. The barriers will deployed in a manner to provide extended runoff in the corners, in combination with Airfence and ToughBlocks.

f. Sturgis On-Track Testing:

- i. Bryan Smith rode the full Sturgis TT circuit at pace during a closed-course test on Tuesday, June 11, 2024.
- ii. The motorcycle was equipped with DUNLOP flat track race tires.
- iii. The asphalt provided consistent grip throughout the course.
- iv. Street features such as painted lines and manhole covers did not cause any noticeable reduction in traction.
- v. The transitions from street into the dirt section and back to the street were consistent.

g. **DUNLOP Tire Testing:**

- i. DUNLOP has conducted tire testing on two separate occasions with full-time test riders Taylor Knapp and Jesse Wentland at the DUNLOP Proving Ground in Huntsville, Alabama.
- ii. Test circuits included asphalt course based on Sturgis TT dimensions as well as offroad portions of facility.
- iii. Multiple continuous forty (40) lap sessions were conducted.
- iv. DUNLOP DT4 tires were tested in the F5, R5 and R7 compounds. Based on this thorough testing regimen, DUNLOP DT4 flat track tires possess the required level of performance, endurance and integrity for use on the Sturgis TT course.
- v. The F5 and R7 will be mandated for Mission AFT SuperTwins and Parts Unlimited AFT Singles presented by KICKER at the Sturgis TT.
- vi. The DUNLOP Trailmax Raid and Trailmax Mission models were also tested for consideration in AFT AdventureTrackers.
- vii. Recommended starting tire pressures and other relevant information will be forthcoming in the Sturgis TT Event Supplementary Regulations.
