AFT AdventureTrackers Licensing & Entries Now Open

LICENSE FEE & PROCESS

Active AFT Twins and AFT Singles licensed riders:

- Riders with an active AFT Twins or AFT Singles license are eligible to enter into either their primary class (AFT SuperTwins, AFT Singles) or they may participate in both their primary class and the AFT AdventureTrackers class.
- There is no additional license fee for active AFT Twins or AFT Singles licensed riders that want to race in AdventureTrackers, just the entry fee as outlined below.
- Active AFT riders should contact AMA Pro Racing Registration to request a complimentary AFT
 AdentureTrackers rider license and competition number. Please contact Sharon McMillan, AMA Pro Racing's

New AFT Riders and Riders without an active AFT Twins or AFT Singles license for the current season:

- The cost for an AFT AdventureTrackers rider license is \$150 for riders without a current and valid AFT Twins or AFT Singles rider license for the 2024 season.
- All riders must also have a current, valid AMA membership and will be required to validate their AMA membership during the licensing process.

 - o Click Public Licenses on the left, or use this direct link: https://license.amaproracing.com/Home/Licenses
 - o Click the Apply button next to American Flat Track Rider License AdventureTrackers
 - Complete the license application and provide additional information as requested
 - Upload a headshot, as well as pictures of the front & back of your drivers license or government-issued photo ID
 - Digitally sign the electronic waivers
 - You will be asked to upload a completed PDF, scan or picture of the following documents:
 - IRS Form W-9
 - Direct Deposit Authorization Event Purse Distribution
 - Primary Medical Insurance Card
 - imPACT Concussion Test (https://baselinetesting.com)
 - o Finally, submit payment via credit card

ENTRY FEE & PROCESS

- The entry fee for the AFT AdventureTrackers class is \$250.
- Once a license has been approved and a competition number has been assigned, the rider will be assigned to an Affiliate (Team)
- The Affiliate (Team) Manager will receive an email to go to the ProReg Affiliate Management portal to process entries for their riders.



- Visit ProReg Affiliate Management: https://licensemanager.amaproracing.com/
 - o After logging in, find the Affiliate (Team) and click the Manage Entries button
 - Select a Rider's name from the drop-down menu, then select from the list of approved Licenses for that rider.
 - Select a Vehicle, fill in the Sponsor list, check the box at the end of the row and click the Submit button.
 - Teams with multiple riders or multiple entries can submit all of their entries and then process a single payment.
 - Riders that are riding in two classes will have the ability to select from either their primary license (AFT Twins, AFT Singles) to process an entry in their primary class, or the comp AFT AdventureTrackers license -- once it has been approved -- in order to process their second entry for the event in the AdventureTrackers class.
 - Once all entries have been submitted, click the Payments button on the left and then click the Make Entry Payment button at the top right.
 - Select which entries you would like to purchase, then click the **Send Payment** button to provide your credit card information.
 - Once AMA Pro Racing Registration approves the entry, it will appear on the entry lists at AmericanFlatTrack.com or the Competitor Information section at AMAProRacing.com.

ENTRY DEADLINE

The entry deadline for the **Sturgis TT is Sunday, August 4.** Entry fees will be increased by \$100.00 for late entries submitted after the entry deadline. All 2024 Progressive American Flat Track events are **Pre-Entry ONLY and entries will not be accepted at the events**. EVENT ENTRIES

ProReg, AMA Pro Racing's new digital licensing platform, also includes an Affiliate Management portal for managing teams, purchasing licenses for team members and submitting entries for riders to participate in race events. **If you are a team owner, team manager or privateer, please log into the ProReg Affiliate Manager portal at the following URL: https://licensemanager.amaproracing.com**

After you are logged in, you can invite your team members to apply for licenses by clicking **Add Member**. After your team members have completed their applications, click **Payments** to process payment for multiple licenses in a single transaction. Once a Team's rider has been an approved for a Rider License, you can click **Manage Entries** to submit an entry for an upcoming race event.
